The first question lets the teams set their benchmark, and for each subsequent question they just need to say if they think it is lower or higher than the previous answer. Keep all the numbers, including the benchmark, secret, until you give the answers!

Answer: HIGHER [925]
7. UK Billionaires as of 2025 **Answer: LOWER** [156]
8. Maximum break in snooker without a foul
Answer: LOWER [147]
9. Minutes in a day **Answer: HIGHER** [1,440]
10. Races in Formula 1 since it started **Answer: LOWER** [1,137]

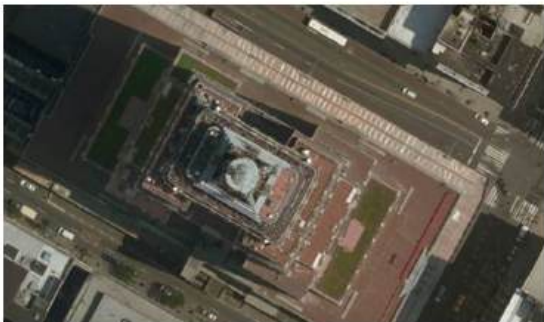

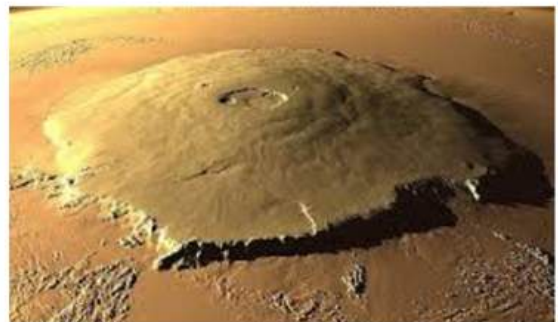
