Together Network

Social isolation, loneliness, homelessness and debt are preventing local people and communities from flourishing.

We know that churches are working hard in their local communities, but without support they cannot reach every person in need.

The Together Network is a membership of faith-based partnerships focused on the needs and priorities of the communities they serve. We have found that sharing ideas, experience and contacts helps equip churches to tackle social inequality, transform neighbourhoods and change lives.

Near Neighbours

In many neighbourhoods across England, different faith and ethnic communities live and work next to each other, yet rarely interact with one another.

Such separation can lead to misunderstanding and a lack of trust or respect for one another. Yet it is local people, in local communities, who are ideally placed to identify and develop solutions that can improve their own neighbourhood.

Near Neighbours have been working with local partners across England to bring people together, so they can get to know each other, build relationships of trust and collaborate on initiatives that improve the community they live in.





Financial education and training

Financial distress has become endemic in Britain. This is due to a combination of growing inequality and poverty, a banking sector dominated by large banks that are slow to adapt, a long-standing culture of reluctance to talking about and manage money, and lack of interventions to raise financial capability.

20.3 million people in the UK don't feel confident managing their money. A further 11.5 million have less than £100 in savings and nearly 9 million are in serious debt.

Thanks to people like you, the Just Finance Foundation is helping people avoid and find ways out of financial distress by building their financial capability and providing relevant support and signposting to self-help and services. At the same time, we help provide quality financial education to primary schools, ensure future generations can talk about and manage money well.
