When life throws one challenge, you can usually cope. But for Colin, everything started to fall apart at once – and it wasn't long before he found himself homeless...

When my dad died, life became a real struggle," remembers Colin.
"I ended up living on a golf course in a tent. I managed to keep going to work each day, but I only had one hot meal a week and lived off ham sandwiches."

One day, Colin was invited to a CUF-supported Place of Welcome at a local church. The church had received a grant and started a weekly drop-in session, offering tea, coffee, hot food and a warm place to sit. "It was welcoming, warm and friendly," said Colin.

Through the connection with church, Colin began accessing other support... A food bank. Help with housing. The love and care of local Christians. "I was invited to a church service, and it was nothing like I expected," said Colin. "It's like a family here."

In time, Colin became a Christian and was baptised. He's now a volunteer at the church. "It's helping me move forwards," said Colin with a smile.
"I'm making progress, step by step."

Your questions answered

WHAT KIND OF GIFT CAN I LEAVE?

There are two main ways to leave a gift in your will:

- A share of your estate
- A fixed-sum cash gift

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A WILL?

Please use a solicitor to draw one up. Any solicitor local to you can provide help or advice, and can ensure your will is legal and valid.

CAN I AMEND MY WILL?

If you already have a will, it's a good idea to review it to make sure it reflects your wishes. You can update your will at any time. Amending your will to include Church Urban Fund is very simple.

WHAT ABOUT INHERITANCE TAX?

Charitable gifts are usually free of inheritance tax. Gifts in wills can also help reduce inheritance tax on the rest of your estate. A solicitor can advise you.
